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DECISION

- 1. In accordance with section 21 of the *Electricity Industry Act 2004* (Act), the Economic Regulation Authority (Authority) has approved an amendment to Electricity Generation Licence No.5 (EGL5).
- The amendment entails that the licensee name be changed from Transfield Services Kemerton Pty Limited to RATCH-Australia Kemerton Pty Ltd, and the licence address to:

REASONS

- 3. The licensee changed its business name and registered office with the Australian Securities & Investment Commission.
- 4. The licensee informed the Authority of its change in name and address on 13 July 2012.
- 5. Pursuant to section 21 of the Act, the licensee applied to the Authority to amend EGL5 in order to reflect its new business name and registered office address.
- 6. Pursuant to section 21(4) of the Act, the Authority may amend a licence if the applicant has made the application in a form approved by the Authority, paid the prescribed application fee and additional information has been provided for proper consideration of the application. The licensee has satisfied these requirements.
- 7. This is a minor amendment and the Authority considered it unnecessary to seek public consultation on the amendment.
