Call for Expressions of Interest

ECCC MEMBERSHIP TERM 2013 - 2015

Expressions of interest are called for eight representatives from industry and consumer organisations to join the Electricity Code Consultative Committee (ECCC) for a two-year term.

The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) established the ECCC in 2006 to provide advice to the Authority on matters relating to the *Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers* (**Code**).

The Code regulates and controls the conduct of retailers, distributors and electricity marketing agents that supply and market electricity to residential and non-residential small use customers (customers who consume no more than 160 MWh of electricity per annum).

As required under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ECCC undertakes a review of the Code and provides advice to the Authority every two years.

The Authority has approved the ECCC's new terms of reference and is seeking four people from industry or industry representative organisations, and four people from consumer organisations. Members are appointed as individual members, not organisational members, and may be eligible for remuneration, allowance or reimbursement.

A copy of the new terms of reference is available on the Authority's website.

Appointments to the ECCC will begin on 1 April 2013.
