Summary

Change Energy intends to actively promote and sell grid electricity, solar PV, energy efficiency and energy management to all contestable customers in the SWIS.

Change Energy's target market will be small to medium businesses, specifically RT4, RT5 and RT6 customers. According to information from Western Power, there are approximately 17,500 customers in this segment using approximately 4,000,000 MWh. Change Energy's market share target is approximately 2.5% in both customers and volume.

Change Energy expects to enter the residential market segment upon the de-regulation of that market in the near future.

Public Interest Information

a) environmental considerations:

It is anticipated that Change Energy will facilitate the greater penetration of solar PV on the SWIS, increasing the production and use of renewable energy. Energy efficiency and energy management will reduce customer usage. Both of these will result in a positive impact on the environment.

b) social welfare and equity considerations, including community service obligations:

Increased competition will result in lower grid energy costs. The higher uptake of renewable energy and energy efficiency also indirectly increases competition which will lead to lower overall costs. Energy management services will empower customers to make more informed choices, giving them greater control.

c) economic and regional development factors, including employment and investment growth:

Lower energy costs as a result of competition (direct and indirect) may release funds which could be used for further investment in the customer's underlying business and therefore facilitate economic and employment growth.

d) the interests of customers generally or of a class of customers

Competition in the SWIS will be increased/enhanced by the entry of a new energy retailer and solar/energy efficiency provider which will benefit customers who are contestable and able to source energy from Change Energy. Specifically, RT4, RT5 and RT6 customers which encompass approximately 17,500 customers in WA.

e) the interests of any licensee, or applicant for a licence, in respect of the area or areas to which the order, if made, would apply:

Competition in the SWIS will be increased/enhanced by the entry of a new energy retailer and solar/energy efficiency provider, which may be to the detriment of existing licence holders. The entry of Change Energy may result in loss of market share by other energy retailers in the SWIS. Further, increased renewable energy penetration may delay or eliminate the investment in other energy sources, resulting in reduced returns for those plants.

f) the importance of competition in electricity and gas industry markets:

Grant of this licence to Change Energy will directly and indirectly enhance competition in the electricity market. Competition drives efficiency in both the production and use of energy.

g) the policy objectives of government in relation to the supply of electricity and gas

Grant of this licence to Change Energy will promote the Wholesale Electricity Market Objectives:

- Promote the economically efficient, safe and reliable production and supply of electricity and electricity-related services in the SWIS.
 - Through increased competition which increases efficiency and increased solar generation which will increase reliability
- Encourage competition among generators and retailers in the SWIS, including by facilitating efficient entry of new competitors.
 - A retail licence will result in Change Energy becoming a market participant, trading with existing participants, improving market efficiency and transparency.
- Avoid discrimination in that market against particular energy options and technologies, including sustainable energy options and technologies such as those that make use of renewable resources or that reduce overall greenhouse gas emissions.
 - Change Energy's approach will use all technologies in order to provide the best outcome to customers. This will include solar, which will reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- Minimise the long-term cost of electricity supplied to customers from the SWIS.

- Increased competition will improving market efficiency and transparency will reduce long term costs
