**1. Please provide your views on the proposal, including any objections or suggested revisions.**

System Management proposes to amend the Market Rules to allow increased flexibility in relation to information required under Market Rules 3.16.4 and 3.17.5.

System Management proposes to use the change to remove firm obligations on Market Participants to provide information System Management does not currently use in order to complete the PASA process. Instead the change would give System Management the discretion to ask for the information should it be required in future.

Synergy views System Management's proposal as having some merit and does not foresee any material adverse impacts on Synergy's operations. As such, Synergy supports the proposal at this stage.
