Reasons for the Extension

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for publishing the Final Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled “Clarification of Reviewable Decisions and Definition of Regulations” by four Business Days.

The date of publication for the Final Rule Change Report is extended to Friday, 21 December 2012.

The publication date for the Final Rule Change Report has been extended to allow the IMO sufficient time to complete its internal review process for the Rule Change Proposal.

The extension is within the time limits prescribed in clause 2.5.11 of the Market Rules for a Rule Change Proposal subject to the Fast Track Rule Change Process.

Proposed Work Programme

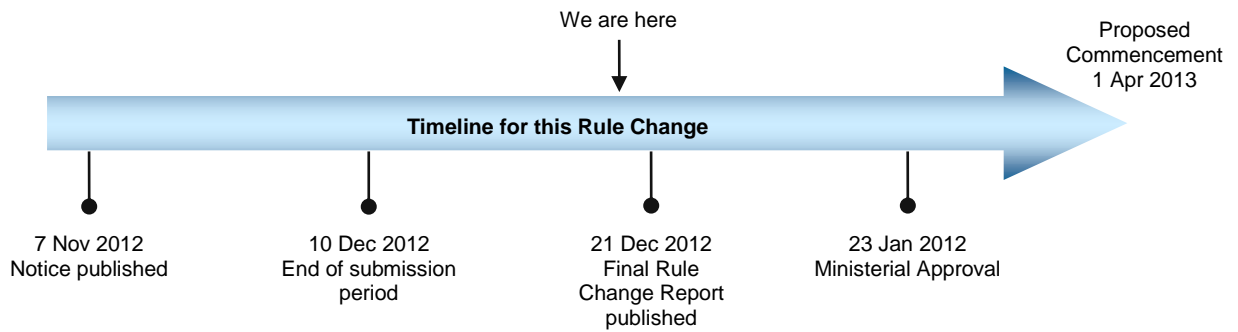
- The IMO completes its internal review process and presents its final decision in the Final Rule Change Report.
