

## Rule Change Extension Notice

### Clarification of Reviewable Decisions and Definition of Regulations

(RC\_2012\_06)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for the consultation period for the Rule Change Proposal titled “Clarification of Reviewable Decisions and Definition of Regulations” (RC\_2012\_06).

The end date of the consultation period is extended by eight Business Days until **Monday, 10 December 2012**. Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process are extended accordingly.

#### Reason for the Extension

Following internal review and discussion with the Public Utilities Office (PUO), the IMO identified that clauses 2.5.7(e), 2.6.4(f) and 2.7.8(e) of the Market Rules are similar to clause 2.10.2A in that they all refer to the publication of the IMO’s decisions, rather than to the decisions themselves. The IMO considers that in all four cases the clauses that are subject to Procedural Review should explicitly refer to the relevant decisions. To achieve this, the IMO intends to publish an addendum proposing some further changes to the proposed Amending Rules for RC\_2012\_06.

To allow the PUO and other interested parties adequate time to consider these additional changes, the IMO has extended the consultation period for RC\_2012\_06.

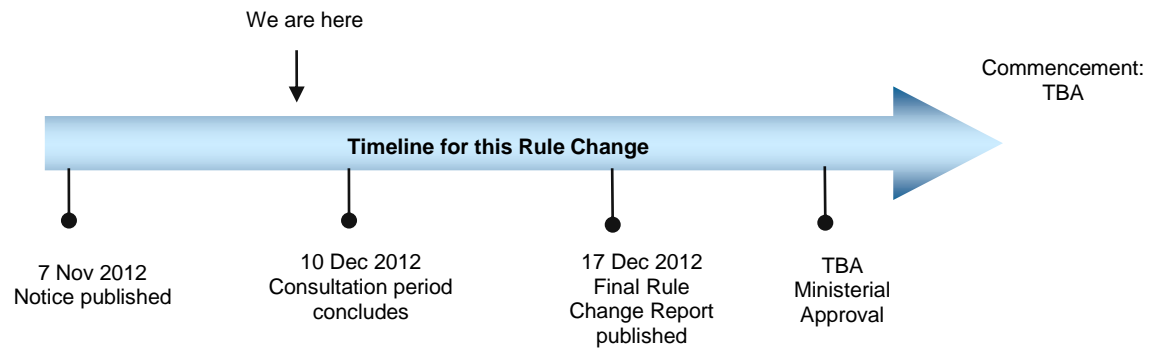

- The Minister considers the Rule Change Proposal and makes a decision regarding the proposed amending rules.
