Decision on the Rottneest Island Authority's proposed metrology procedure

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) has published its [decision](#) to approve the Rottneest Island Authority's (RIA) proposed metrology procedure.

The RIA has complied with the consultation requirements of the *Electricity Industry (Metering) Code 2012* and its metrology procedure meets the necessary criteria for approval.

The ERA's decision is subject to administrative amendments being made to the metrology procedure.

These amendments do not materially change the metrology procedure for Rottneest Island.

BACKGROUND

The Code requires the RIA to establish a metrology procedure and for this procedure to be approved by the ERA.

The metrology procedure provides guidance on the provision, installation and maintenance of metering equipment connected to the electricity network on Rottneest Island.

Following the ERA's approval, and within 10 business days, the RIA must publish the approved metrology procedure on its website.
