Benchmark reserve capacity price for the 2021/22 capacity year

FINAL DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved a revised benchmark reserve capacity price for the 2021/22 capacity year of \$154,200 per megawatt per year, as recommended by the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO).

The approved revised price for the 2021/22 capacity year will be effective from the date specified in a notice to be published on AEMO's website.

This approval is granted under clause 2.26.1 of the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules (18 October 2018) on the basis that:

- The revised value for the benchmark reserve capacity price reasonably reflects the application of the method and guiding principles described in clause 4.16 of the market rules.
- AEMO has carried out an adequate public consultation process.
