Blair Fox Energy Retail Pty Ltd

2024 performance audit

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the <u>2024 performance audit report</u> for Blair Fox Energy Retail Pty Ltd's electricity retail licence ERL17.

Blair Fox supplies electricity to nine large use customers on the South West Interconnected System from its 5 megawatt Karakin Wind Farm. Blair Fox does not supply small use customers.¹

The ERA's decision

The ERA considers that Blair Fox has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence.

The ERA has decided to increase the audit period from 48 months to 60 months. The next audit will cover the period 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2029, with the report due to be provided by 30 June 2029.

Audit findings

The audit of the 68 licence obligations applicable to Blair Fox did not find any non-compliances or controls deficiencies. Blair Fox has demonstrated a high level of compliance with its licence obligations in its last two audits.

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¹ A 'small use customer' is a customer who consumes not more than 160 megawatt hours of electricity per year.
