BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust

Consultation on application to amend electricity generation licence EGL29

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application by BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust to amend its electricity generation licence EGL29.

BEI is proposing to expand Warradarge Wind Farm, located approximately 260 kilometres north of Perth in the Shire of Coorow, by increasing its capacity from 180 to 283 megawatts. This expansion will involve constructing an additional 30 wind turbines, resulting in a total of 81 turbines on site, and extending the licence area to accommodate the additional turbines.

A summary of the <u>amendment application</u>, including a map, is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licence amendment is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so. When considering this application, the ERA must also have regard to section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which includes considering the long-term interests of consumers.

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the amendment application.
