Electricity Generation and Retail Corporation trading as Synergy

Consultation on electricity generation application

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Synergy's application for construction and operation of the King Rocks Wind Farm, a proposed 103 Megawatt wind farm located approximately 35 kilometres north-east of the Hyden townsite in the Shire of Kondinin.

The licensed services will be limited to electricity generation. All power produced will be internally transferred to Synergy's wholesale business unit for sale into the Western Australian energy market.

A summary of the <u>licence application</u> is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licence is subject to the ERA being satisfied it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

has, and is likely to retain,

or

• will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

The ERA must also have regard to the matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.
