BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust

Approval of application to amend electricity generation licence EGL29

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved an application by BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust to amend its electricity generation licence EGL29. The Warradarge Wind Farm will expand its licence operating area to construct 30 additional wind turbine generators, increasing its capacity from 180 Megawatts (MW) to 283MW.

To accommodate the optimal layout of additional wind turbine generators, the ERA has approved expanding the boundary of the licence area from 5,108 hectares (ha) to 7,059ha. The new wind turbine generators will be the same model currently in use on the site. Power generated at the wind farm will continue to be sold to Synergy under long-term power purchase agreements.

The Warradarge Wind Farm is located in the Mid West approximately 260km north Perth in the Shire of Coorow, bordering the Shire of Carnamah. The licence is held by the Bright Energy Investments group which operates the Albany Grasmere Wind Farm and Greenough River Solar Farm.

On 8 January 2025, the ERA published the <u>licence amendment application</u> for public comment. No submissions were received.

The ERA reviewed the application in accordance with the requirements of *Electricity Industry Act 2004* and *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003* and determined that approving this amendment is not contrary to the public interest. The expansion of the wind farm will increase the capacity of renewable generation in the South West Interconnected System.
