### APPLICATIONS FOR ELECTRICITY LICENCES

The Economic Regulation Authority advises that individuals and organisations that supply or sell electricity in Western Australia will need to apply for a licence by 31 December 2005. Anyone who intends to sell or supply electricity will need to be licensed, unless they qualify for an exemption under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*.

Standard Electricity Licences, Guidelines for Electricity Licence Applications and an Electricity Licence Application Form have been developed in consultation with stakeholders and are available on the Authority's website. These have been revised and it is important that intending applicants for licences obtain the latest information from the Authority's website at [www.era.wa.gov.au/electricity/electricityLicensing.cfm](http://www.era.wa.gov.au/electricity/electricityLicensing.cfm).

Applicants are also reminded that they should contact the Authority to determine the amount of information required to support their application as this will depend on their level of financial and technical resources, project finance and level of technical expertise. It is likely therefore that the amount of information required will vary between applicants.
