### **INQUIRY ON THE COST OF SUPPLYING BULK POTABLE WATER TO KALGOORLIE-BOULDER**

The Treasurer, the Hon Eric Ripper MLA, today tabled in Parliament the Economic Regulation Authority's final report of the Inquiry into the Cost of Supplying Bulk Potable Water to Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

The final report examines the cost of supplying potable water to Kalgoorlie-Boulder, Esperance and surrounding regions, and the cost to the Water Corporation if a private sector company, United Utilities Australia, provided bulk potable water to the region from its proposed desalination plant at Esperance and water pipeline to Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
