EXTENSION OF TIME - PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS - PARMELIA PIPELINE

This is to advise that an extension of time has been arranged to allow interested parties to make submissions in respect of the proposed Access Arrangement and Access Arrangement Information for the Parmelia Pipeline (Licence Numbers WA:PLs 1-3, 5 & 23). This extension of time for submissions is for a period of 21 days until 4 pm WST Monday 5 July 1999 and has been arranged to give interested parties time to consider additional information which will become available shortly.

The proposed Access Arrangement provides details of the terms and conditions including price on which CMS Gas Transmission Australia (CMS) will provide third parties with access to the Parmelia pipeline.

CMS lodged its proposed Access Arrangement and Access Arrangement Information on 7 May 1999. Public submissions were called on 15 May 1999 to close at 4 pm Monday 14 June 1999. The Notice calling for public submissions was placed on the *OffGAR* web site (www.offgar.wa.gov.au) and appeared in the West Australian and Weekend Australian newspapers on Saturday 15 May 1999.

Confidentiality

In general, all submissions from interested parties will be treated as in the public domain and placed on the *OffGAR* web site. Where an interested party wishes to keep part or all of the contents of a submission confidential, it should indicate these parts clearly. However, where the information is not considered to be 'unduly harmful' to the legitimate business interests of any party, the submission may be returned to the party making the submission with the option of revising or withdrawing it.
