PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE ACCESS ARRANGEMENT FOR THE

DAMPIER TO BUNBURY NATURAL GAS PIPELINE

Forecast New Facilities Investment Information

The Economic Regulation Authority (Authority) invites submissions from interested parties on revised forecast New Facilities Investment information and costings recently provided by Dampier Bunbury Pipeline (DBP) as part of a submission in response to the Draft Decision for that pipeline. This information and costings are contained in Annexure 3 of the amended Proposed Revised Access Assessment Information (PRAAI).

The Authority said in paragraph 167 of the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (DBNGP) Draft Decision, issued on 11 May 2005, that it would provide interested parties an opportunity to comment on this revised forecast New Facilities Investment information and costings.

DBP has provided the PRAAI as one of its submissions to the Draft Decision. This submission has been placed on the Authority's website <u>www.era.wa.gov.au</u>, together with all other non-confidential submissions received during the public submission period following release of the Draft Decision.

The Authority is seeking submissions on the revised forecast New Facilities Investment information and costings as contained in Annexure 3 of the amended PRAAI. These submissions should be in both electronic (email to <u>russell.dumas@era.wa.gov.au</u>) and written form and must be received by is **4pm** on **25 June 2005.**

The receipt and publication of any submission lodged shall not be taken as indicating that the Authority has formed an opinion as to whether or not any particular submission contains any information of a confidential nature and no duty of confidence will arise from the Authority in these circumstances.

Submissions made to the Authority will be treated as in the public domain and placed on the Authority's website unless confidentiality is claimed. Parts of the submission in relation to which confidentiality is claimed should be clearly marked. Any claim of confidentiality will be considered in accordance with the provisions of sections 7.11 to 7.14 of the Code.
