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# NOTICE

## EXTENSIONS OF TIME

This is to advise that the periods for assessment of the proposed Access Arrangements for the pipelines listed below have been extended. Sections 2.21 and 2.22 of the National Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipeline Systems require that the period for assessing a proposed Access Arrangement be extended by up to 2 months on one or more occasions if the total period of assessment exceeds 6 months.

The Draft Decisions on the proposed Access Arrangements for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline and the Goldfields Gas Pipeline are expected to be issued in April 2001 and March 2001 respectively. The Final Decision on the proposed Access Arrangement for the Tubridgi Pipeline System is expected to be issued in the second quarter of 2001.

The pipelines for which the assessment period has been extended are as follows:

- Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (licence number WA: PL 40) to 15 April 2001.
- Goldfields Gas Pipeline (licence number WA: PL 24) to 15 April 2001.
- Tubridgi Pipeline System (licence numbers WA: PL 16 and 19) to 21 April 2001.

These extensions of time are pursuant to section 2.22 of the Code.
