### Invitation for Public Submissions

#### Review of Public Transport Authority's Part 5 Instruments

The Economic Regulation Authority has received the Public Transport Authority's proposed Part 5 instruments for approval under the *Railways (Access) Code 2000*.

The documents submitted, as required by the Code, were the [Train Management Guidelines](#), the [Statements of Policy](#) (Train Path Policy), the [Costing Principles](#) and the [Over-Payment Rules](#). These have been placed on the Authority's web site.

The Independent Rail Access Regulator had previously approved the Train Management Guidelines and Train Path Policy in March 2003, the Costing Principles in April 2003 and the Over-Payment Rules in July 2003.

#### Public Submissions

The Authority has invited submissions from interested parties on the PTA's proposed Part 5 instruments, in accordance with the Code. All submissions should be in electronic and hard copy form and must be received by **4:00pm (Western Standard Time) on Friday 17 August 2007**.
