AMENDMENTS TO LICENCE EIRL 2

Horizon Power requests that licence EIRL 2 be amended to record licence boundary changes, as follows.

- (1) Kalumburu This is the next community to be supplied as part of the Aboriginal and Remote Communities Power Supply Project (ARCPSP). Funding comes in stages and is not available until the project to supply a community has received approval. As a consequence a licence application is not made until this approval is given. Kalumburu has now received this approval and is expected to be completed by November 2010.
- (2) Pilbara Horizon Power is awaiting approval from the Minister of Energy to enter into a new Power Supply Agreement (PSA) and a Connection Assets Agreement (CAA) with Fortesque Metal Group. The Minister of Energy must formally approve the new PSA and CAA before Horizon Power can enter into these agreements. One of the outcomes of these agreements will be that Horizon Power will take possession of the transmission line running between Wedgefield sub-station and South West Creek substation from FMG. Horizon Power will be deemed to have acquired the transmission line when the agreements are executed. The transmission line is currently not in a Horizon Power licence area and will be required be included in the Pilbara licence.
- (3) Karratha Three new projects have been quoted by Horizon Power and have now been given funding approval. Horizon Power is not able to apply for extensions to operating areas until project funding is approved. The three projects are currently not within Horizon Power's existing boundary areas and so will require licence boundary amendments to incorporate the following:
 - (a) Main Roads have asked Horizon Power to provide "points of supply" along the Dampier Highway to facilitate additional street lighting between Dampier and Karratha,

- (b) the Nickol subdivision is to be extended and Horizon Power is to provide the infrastructure to the new works and,
- (c) Horizon Power will provide power to the new industrial estate being built at Gap Ridge.

All three projects are expected to be energised from late 2010 to early 2011.


(4) Onslow – No changes have been made to the Onslow boundary but as Onslow has backup generation (similar to Kununurra and Wyndham) the reference to that generation has been included on the map.


